## ASTHMA MANAGEMENT

### DESCRIPTION

This course applies to a wide range of settings where emergencies involving asthma attacks may occur. It is relevant for people working in childcare, education, aged and community care, sport, tourism, hospitality, industry enterprises and other environments.

There are no prerequisites for this course, however an appropriate level of numeracy and literacy and communication is required to be able to call for help and provide relevant information.

### DURATION

3 hours classroom training and assessment.

### ASSESSMENT METHOD

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills and written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge.

- + Emergency treatment of asthma
- + Risk minimization and management strategies for asthma emergencies
