ENTER AND WORK IN A CONFINED SPACE

DESCRIPTION

This entry level training includes entry and exit procedures, assessment of associated risks and how to operate safely in a confined space which is at atmospheric pressure during occupancy.

PREREQUISITES

Acceptable level of health for training in confined space environment.

DURATION

7 Hours classroom assessment and training, including a workplace scenario.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Continuous assessment throughout the course, written and practical assessment and participation in a group activity

- + Confined spaces (definition, general hazards, personnel)
- + Atmospheres, gas detection equipment and monitoring
- + Emergency response, PPE, safety equipment
- + Hazard identification
- + Entry procedure and entry permit for working in or on confined space
