



# AUSTRALIAN FIRE & FIRST AID

## WORK SAFELY WITH HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

### DESCRIPTION

This course applies to the manufacturing industry, but is also applicable to any workplace where hazardous materials or dangerous goods may be encountered. It is relevant for personnel who are required to respond to an incident such as a leak, spill or other incident. The worker is not expected to deal with the emerging incident, but to provide an initial first response in order to contain the incident and/or secure the immediate area in order to minimise resultant damages and loss.

### PREREQUISITES

Acceptable level of education required to undergo training and assessment.

### DURATION

4 Hours classroom training and assessment.

### ASSESSMENT METHOD

Continuous assessment throughout the course, written and practical assessment of essential skills.

### COURSE CONTENT

- + Hazards in the workplace
- + Recognising an emergency situation
- + Following established workplace emergency procedures
- + Assessing the level of severity
- + Undertaking routine response to minimise effect of emergency
- + Notification of responsible authorities
- + Undertaking safe evacuation
- + Securing the area of an incident
