LOW VOLTAGE RESCUE AND CPR

DESCRIPTION

This course applies to all trades, particularly in situations where live electrical work is performed. While particularly relevant for electricians, it is also relevant for persons working in any industry where contact with electrical components, wiring or machinery is likely.

PREREQUISITES

Students must hold a current and valid CPR certificate which is included in this course. Must have appropriate level of education to undertake assessment.

DURATION

4 hours classroom training and assessment.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills and written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge.
